#### Policy 422: Policies Incorporated by Reference

The purpose of this policy is to avoid undue duplication of policies.

#### **Policy 424: License Status**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that qualified teachers are employed by the school district and to fulfill its duty to ascertain the licensure status of its teachers.

#### Policy 513: Student Promotion, Retention, and Program Design

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to professional staff, parents, and students regarding student promotion, retention, and program design.

# **Policy 601: School District Curriculum and Instruction Goals**

The purpose of this policy is to establish broad curriculum parameters for the school district that encompass the Minnesota Academic Standards and federal law and are aligned with creating the world's best workforce.

# Policy 602: Organization of School Calendar and School Day

The purpose of this policy is to provide for a timely determination of the school calendar and school day.

# **Policy 603: Curriculum Development**

The purpose of this policy is to provide direction for continuous review and improvement of the school curriculum.

#### **Policy 604: Instructional Curriculum**

The purpose of this policy is to provide for the development of course offerings for students.

### **Policy 605: Alternative Educational Services**

The purpose of this policy is to set forth requirements for graduation from the school district.

#### Policy 614: School District Testing Plan and Procedure

The purpose of this policy is to set forth the school district's testing plan and procedure.

# <u>Policy 615: Testing Accommodations, Modifications, and Exemptions for IEPs, Section 504 Plans, and LEP</u> Students

The purpose of the policy is to provide adequate opportunity for students identified as having individualized education program (IEP), Rehabilitation Act of 1973, § 504 accommodation plan (504 plan), or English Learner (EL) needs to participate in statewide assessment systems designed to hold schools accountable for the academic performance of all students.

#### Policy 616: School District System Accountability

The purpose of this policy is to focus public education strategies on a process that promotes higher academic achievement for all students and ensures broad-based community participation in decisions regarding the implementation of the Minnesota K-12 Academic Standards and federal law.

#### Policy 618: Assessment of Student Achievement

The purpose of this policy is to institute a process for the establishment and revision of assessments to measure achievement toward meeting the Minnesota Academic Standards, track academic progress over time, and provide Minnesota graduates information related to career and college readiness.

#### Policy 619: Staff Development for Standards

The purpose of this policy is to establish opportunities for staff development which advance the staff's ability to work effectively with the Graduation Assessment Requirements and with students as they progress to achievement of those Graduation Assessment Requirements and meet the requirements of federal law.

# **Policy 620: Credit for Learning**

This policy recognizes student achievement that occurs in postsecondary enrollment option and other advanced enrichment programs.

#### **Policy 425: Staff Development and Mentoring**

The purpose of this policy is to establish a staff development program and structure to carry out planning and reporting on staff development that supports improved student learning.

# Policy 534: School Meals Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that students receive healthy and nutritious meals through the school district's nutrition program and that the school district employees, families, and students have a shared understanding of expectations regarding meal charges.

#### Policy 621: Literacy and Read Acts

The purpose of this policy is to align with Minnesota law established in the Read Act and on other topics related to reading.

# **Policy 624: Online Learning**

The purpose of this policy is to recognize and govern online instruction options of students enrolled in the school district for purposes of compulsory attendance and address enrollment of students with an online instruction site for supplemental or full-time online learning.

# Policy 617: School District Ensurance of Preparatory and High School Standards

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all locally adopted preparatory and high school content standards of the Profile of Learning are addressed directly in both curriculum and assessment for all students, including those with special needs.
